Common Scams

Scammers can be extremely convincing and will play on your fears and sympathies to try to get you to cooperate.

Don't let them scare or bully you.

If you get a call from a business or government agency requesting payment via Money-Pak, hang up. If you think you may really owe money, call the business or agency directly. If you get a call from a person you don't know saying they're a relative needing money, hang up. Call someone else in your family close to that person to see if they really need help. If you get an email that looks suspicious, do not reply. Call or email the sender directly. Do not reply to the email or call any numbers provided in the email.
